Eligibility & Guidelines

Love Not Hate Expressions is open to youth up to age 21. All media are eligible. Artwork must be original. Artists, parents, or guardians must sign a hold harmless agreement at the time artwork is delivered. Artists may enter up to two works into the exhibit.

2D and 3D work is accepted. All 2D artwork must be unframed.

Submitted artwork may be used for promotional purposes for the *Love Not Hate Expressions* exhibit, the Children's March for Love, or for any of the partnering presenters.
