# **Artist Advancement Grant 2024**

Artist Advancement grants are intended to directly benefit individual artists by funding the creation of new work, community projects, or the advancement of artists' careers.

## **Eligibility**

- Applicants must live or work in Daviess, Dubois, Gibson, Knox, Perry, Posey, Pike, Vanderburgh, Warrick, or Spencer Counties of Indiana.
- Applicants must be at least 18 years of age, or have a parental or guardian co-applicant
- Applicants may work in any discipline of the visual, literary, or performance arts

#### **Eligible Fund Uses**

Applicants may request up to \$500 for any of the following, or a combination of eligible uses:

- Purchase of supplies or equipment for the creation of new work
- Tuition for classes related to career advancement (arts courses or business courses)
- Entry fees for exhibitions, competitions, contests, auditions, or submissions
- Funds for transporting or shipping work to museums, galleries, or institutions
- Lodging and mileage for non-local performance opportunities
- Business costs (website development, business materials, marketing)
- A community-based project, installation, or performance

## Grants of up to \$500 may be requested.

#### **Selection Criteria**

Applications will be reviewed by a committee of artists and arts administrators. Applications will be evaluated on the following criteria:

- Funds will be used for eligible uses
- Applicant clearly explains how the funds will enable the creation of new art, a community project, or career advancement
- Applicant demonstrates ability to execute proposed project by providing a well-thought out budget and clearly explained plan for use of the funds

Grant Notifications: Aug 28th

Funds Disbursed (and mailed): early September
